

Parts of a Flower

Flower:
(Bloom or Blossom) The flower contains the reproductive organs and it produces seeds.

Seeds:
the part of a plant that can grow into another plant.

Petals:
are leaves that surround the reproductive parts of a flower.

Leaf:
Leaves release excess water, breathe in carbon dioxide and out oxygen, and turn light energy into food through photosynthesis.

Stem:
provide support to the plant by holding the flower, leaves and buds of the plant.

Roots:
Asorb water, and acts as an anchor for plants by keeping them rooted into the ground so they don't fall over.
