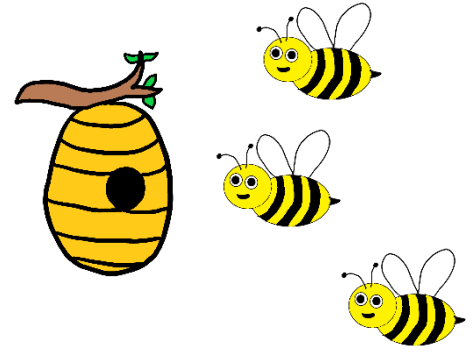


Sight Words Beehive Game



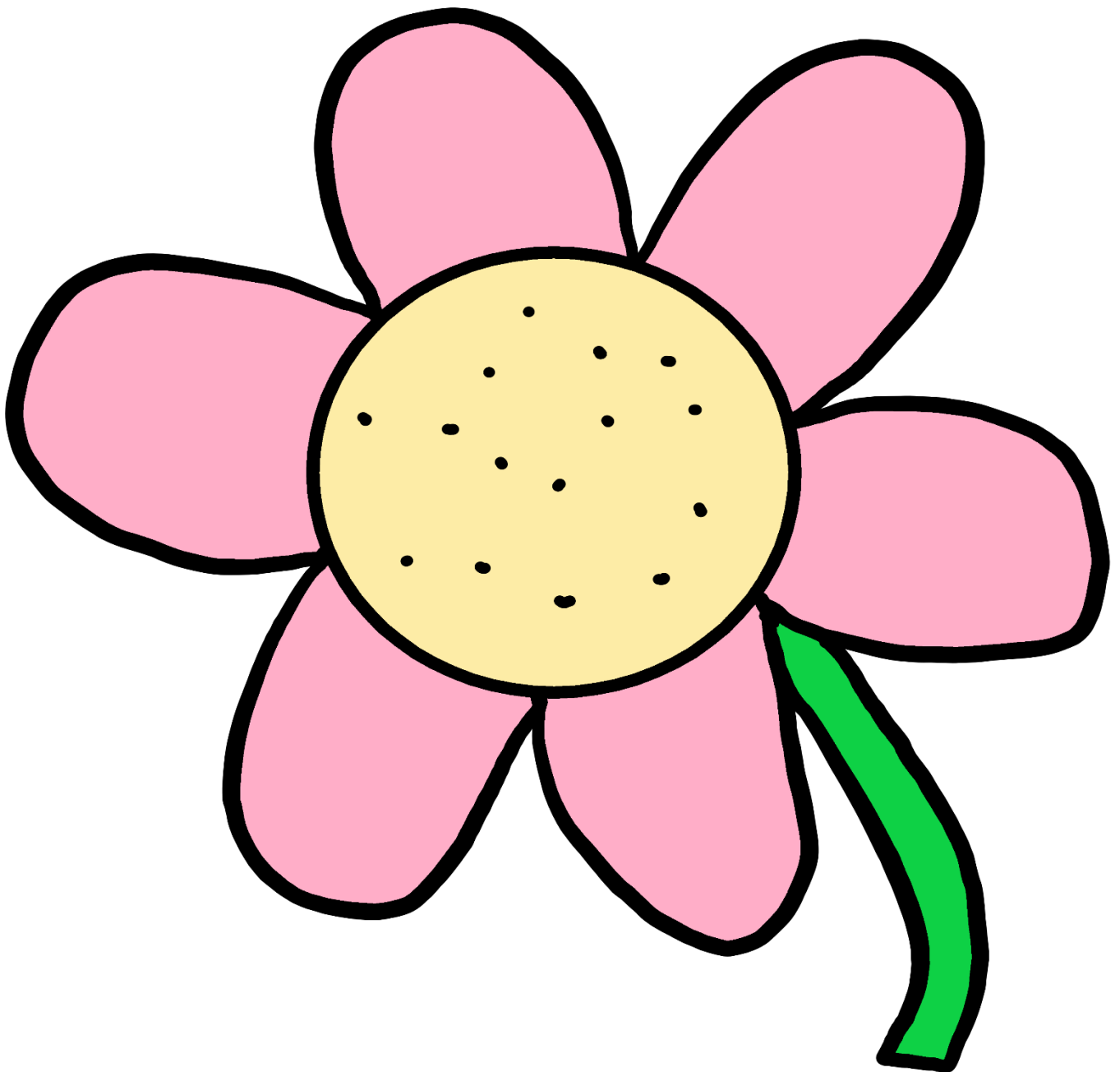
Game setup...

- Each player gets their own beehive.
- All bees start off on the flower face down.
- Numbers of bees varies with age, skill level, and attention span. You could use half a sight word list, a whole list, or mix the sight word lists depending on your children's skill level.

How to Play...

- Youngest player goes first.
- The child reads the bee card they pick from pile, if they get the card correct they place it within their beehive. If they get the card wrong they place it back upon the flower.
- An adult player picks a bee card if the child gets it right they are able to steal the bee card for their own beehive if they get the word wrong the adult says the word for them and places the bee within their beehive.
- Whomever has the most bees in their beehives in the end wins. The length of the game depends on how many cards you start with.
